What is PMM?




Percona Monitoring and Management (PMM) is a best-of-breed open source database monitoring solution. It helps you reduce complexity, optimize performance, and improve the security of your business-critical database environments, no matter where they are located or deployed.

What is PMM?

- Monitoring Tool that works with community and enterprise versions of MySQL,
 MariaDB, MongoDB, and PostgreSQL
- Uses a Client-Server Architecture.
- Requires a PMM client on each host (except for RDS)
- Uses VictoriaMetrics instead of Prometheus since version 2.12

PMM Architecture



How to connect MongoDB to PMM?

Pre-Requisites for connecting to MongoDB

- Create a user and a role for PMM
- Enable Profiling

Connecting PMM to MongoDB

Add the service

pmm-admin add mongodb --username=<username with appropriate role assigned>

 --password=<password here or leave off to be prompted for password>
 --service-name=<name for how your service will show up in PMM> --host=<hostname that is routable by PMM> --port=<mongodb port>
